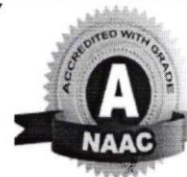

The programme was concluded with vote of thanks by Dr. Anil Kumar (Professor & Head, Department of Mathematics, FoS, SVSU, Meerut.



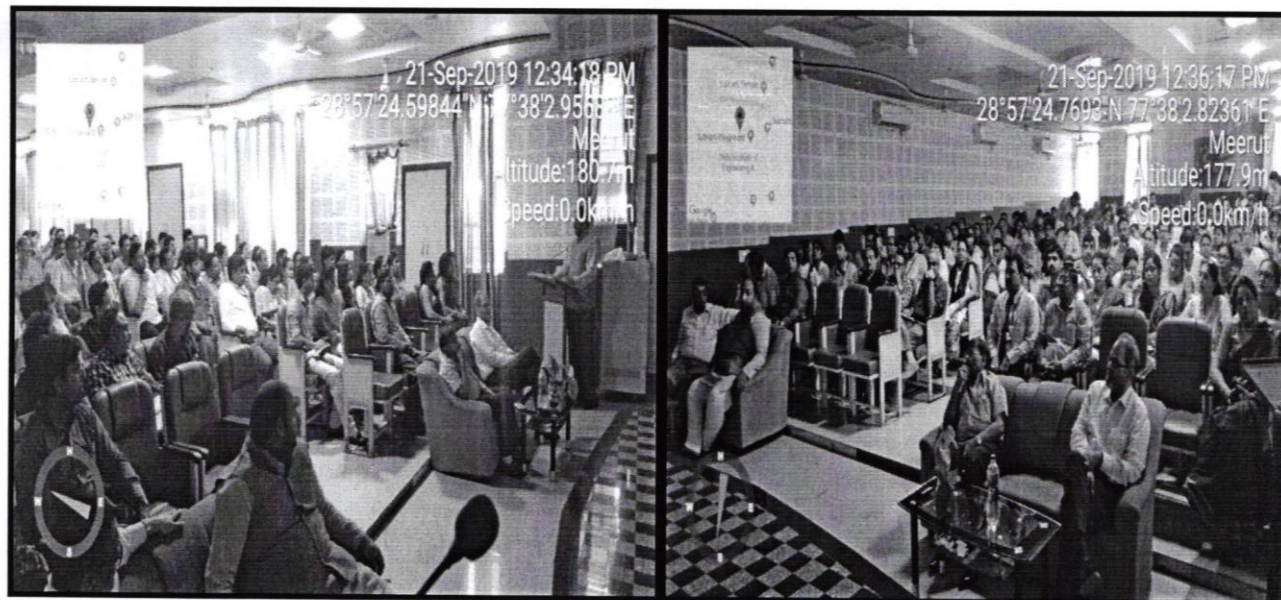
